



ABSTRACTS SUBMISSION

As part of the **XI Liquid Biopsy Symposium**, the organization aims to encourage young researchers' active participation by creating a poster and oral presentation competition showcasing results in liquid biopsy research.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Submitting work to the competition entails full and unconditional acceptance of the following terms and conditions:

- Abstracts with **clinical, translational, or basic research content** in the field of liquid biopsies will be accepted.
- Abstracts should contain fully or partially original results from ongoing or completed work. However, the core body of the results should consist of unpublished data.

Submitting an abstract and having it accepted entitles the first author to free registration.

SELECTION OF ORAL PRESENTATIONS AND PRIZES

Submissions will be evaluated by a panel of experts, who will select 10 abstracts to be **PRESENTED ORALLY** during the symposium (8-minute talk + 2-minute questions). The authors of the selected works will be informed in advance by email. All other accepted abstracts will be presented as posters and will be entered in the best poster award.

Posters:

Posters will be on display during the three-day symposium. The measures must be 120 cm high by 90 cm wide (correct presentation is essential).

Poster session with dedicated poster defense: This session will be held on Friday, January 23rd, from 6:45 p.m to 8:00 p.m., after the selected oral sessions. During this time, poster presenters are expected to be on-site for discussion.

Awards:

There will be awards for the **BEST POSTER** (€ 300) and the **BEST ORAL PRESENTATION** (€ 500). Award winners will be announced during the closing ceremony.

- Each abstract must be submitted individually.

- Any references to patients' or their families' personal details or identity must be omitted.
- Abstracts must be submitted through the abstract platform available on the event's website. [SUBMIT HERE](#)
- **Title:** should be no longer than 20 words.
- **Authors:** please enter the presenting author in the first place (this will be the one contacted by the Technical Secretary).
- **Summaries:** should be no longer than 800 words and include a brief introduction, objectives, methodology, results, and conclusions. Do not write the title or authors in the space reserved for the abstract body.

Before submitting your abstract, the system will ask you for a username and a password with which you will be able to: submit further abstracts, edit your abstracts until the submission deadline, and edit your registration data.

Authors will be notified of acceptance by email.

IMPORTANT

Your registration will be waived if you submit an abstract to the symposium. However, please note that this benefit does not apply to the networking event.
