The core concept is practical integration: quantitative echocardiography as the scalable front-line tool, with CMR providing complementary phenotyping and clarification when needed.

- Review the clinical value of quantitative imaging in cardio-oncology beyond conventional LVEF assessment.
- Discuss how advanced echocardiographic and CMR biomarkers can refine risk stratification, enable earlier detection of cardiotoxicity, and support longitudinal follow-up.
- Demonstrate, through case-based discussion, how imaging innovations can be integrated into routine cardio-oncology practice.
